

Ireland in Rowing



PARIS 2024

This data visualization is comparing the times of the competitors in the Mens Lightweight Double Sculls races that Ireland, the gold medal winner of this event, participated in. The three races depicted are Heat 3, Semifinal A/B 1, and Final A.

Lightweight Men's:

The participants must each weigh 70kg or less. For the women's division, they must weigh 57kg or less.



Double:

Each boat has two rowers.

Sculls:

Each rower has two oars, as opposed to sweep where each rower only has one oar.

Starting on July 28th, the initial heats were run. On the 29th, the repechages, a second chance for teams to qualify for the semifinals if they didn't qualify in the heats, were run. On the 31st, final C was run, followed by the semifinals. On August 2nd, finals A and B were run. Final A determines the rankings for the top 6 teams of the semifinals, final B for the next 6 teams of the semifinals, and so on.
